### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/17-116.7 new 40 ILCS 5/17-116.8 new

30 ILCS 805/8.30 new

Amends the Chicago Teacher Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides an early retirement incentive program for certain teachers who terminate service on or after February 1, 2007 and on or before June 30, 2007 or on or after February 1, 2008 and on or before June 30, 2008. Allows the purchase of up to 5 years of age enhancement and creditable service. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding
Sections 17-116.7 and 17-116.8 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 17-116.7. Early retirement incentives.</u>

#### 8 (a) To be eligible for the benefits provided in this

9 <u>Section, a person must:</u>

(1) be a member of this Fund who, on November 1, 2006, 10 is (i) in active payroll status as a teacher, or (ii) on 11 layoff status from such a position with a right of 12 re-employment or recall to service, or (iii) on leave of 13 14 absence from such a position, but only if the member on 15 leave has not been receiving a disability benefit under this Article for a continuous period of 2 years or more as 16 of the date of application; 17

18 (2) be a member of this Fund who, on or after May 1, 19 2006, is (i) in active payroll status as a teacher, or (ii) on layoff status from such a position with a right of 20 re-employment or recall to service, or (iii) on leave of 21 absence from such a position, but only if the member on 22 leave has not been receiving a disability benefit under 23 this Article for a continuous period of 2 years or more as 24 of the date of application; 25

(3) have not previously received a retirement pension <u>under this Article;</u>

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1 June 30, 2007, unless the applicant's retirement is delayed 2 under subsection (e) or (f) of this Section; (5) be eligible to receive a retirement pension under 3 this Article (for which purpose any age enhancement or 4 5 creditable service received under this Section may be used) and elect to receive the retirement pension beginning no 6 earlier than February 1, 2007 and no later than June 30, 7 2007 or the date established under subsection (e) or (f) of 8

10(6) have attained age 50 (without the use of any age11enhancement or creditable service received under this12Section) by the effective date of the retirement pension;

13(7) have at least 5 years of creditable service under14this Fund or any of the participating systems under the15Retirement Systems Reciprocal Act (without the use of any16creditable service received under this Section) by the17effective date of the retirement pension.

18 (b) An eligible person may establish up to 5 years of 19 creditable service under this Section. In addition, for each 20 period of creditable service established under this Section, a 21 person's age at retirement shall be deemed to be increased by 22 an equal period.

23 <u>The creditable service established under this Section may</u> 24 <u>be used for all purposes under this Article and the Retirement</u> 25 <u>Systems Reciprocal Act, except for the purposes of Section</u> 26 <u>17-116.1, and the determination of average salary or</u> 27 <u>compensation under this or any other Article of this Code.</u>

The age enhancement established under this Section may be 28 used for all purposes under this Article (including calculation 29 of a proportionate pension payable by this Fund under the 30 31 Retirement Systems Reciprocal Act), except for purposes of the reversionary pension under Section 17-120, and distributions 32 required by federal law on account of age. However, age 33 enhancement established under this Section shall not be used in 34 35 determining benefits payable under other Articles of this Code under the Retirement Systems Reciprocal Act. 36

1 <u>(c) For all creditable service established under this</u> 2 <u>Section, the employer must pay to the Fund an employer</u> 3 <u>contribution consisting of 12% of the member's highest annual</u> 4 <u>full-time rate of compensation for each year of creditable</u> 5 <u>service granted under this Section.</u>

The employer contribution shall be paid to the Fund in one 6 of the following ways: (i) in a single sum at the time of the 7 member's retirement, (ii) in equal quarterly installments over 8 9 a period of 5 years from the date of retirement, or (iii) subject to the approval of the Board of the Fund, in unequal 10 11 installments over a period of no more than 5 years from the 12 date of retirement, as provided in a payment plan designed by the Fund to accommodate the needs of the employer. The 13 employer's failure to make the required contributions in a 14 timely manner shall not affect the payment of the retirement 15 16 pension.

For all creditable service established under this Section, the employee must pay to the Fund an employee contribution consisting of 4% of the member's highest annual salary rate used in the determination of the retirement pension for each year of creditable service granted under this Section. The employee contribution shall be deducted from the retirement annuity in 24 monthly installments.

(d) An annuitant who has received any age enhancement or 24 creditable service under this Section and whose pension is 25 suspended or cancelled under Section 17-149 or 17-150 shall 26 27 thereby forfeit the age enhancement and creditable service. The forfeiture of creditable service under this subsection shall 28 not entitle the employer to a refund of the employer 29 30 contribution paid under this Section, nor to forgiveness of any 31 part of that contribution that remains unpaid. The forfeiture of creditable service under this subsection shall not entitle 32 the employee to a refund of the employee contribution paid 33 34 under this Section. 35 (e) If the number of employees of an employer that apply

36 for early retirement under this Section exceeds 30% of those

1 eligible, the employer may require that, for any or all of the 2 number of applicants in excess of that 30%, the starting date of the retirement pension enhanced under this Section be no 3 earlier than June 1, 2007 and no later than September 1, 2007. 4 5 The right to have the retirement pension begin before June 1, 2007 shall be allocated among the applicants on the basis of 6 seniority in the service of that employer. This delay applies 7 only to persons who are applying for early retirement 8 9 incentives under this Section, and does not prevent a person whose application for early retirement incentives has been 10 11 withdrawn from beginning to receive a retirement pension on the 12 earliest date upon which the person is otherwise eligible under 13 this Article. (f) For a member who receives notice that he or she has 14 15 been declared a reserve teacher pursuant to a collective 16 bargaining agreement after January 15, 2007, but before 17 September 15, 2007: (1) the March 1, 2007 application deadline in subdivision (a)(4) of this Section is extended to a date 15 18 days after the <u>date of notification of the reserve teacher</u> 19 20 declaration, (2) the June 30, 2007 deadline in subdivision (a) (5) of this Section is extended to October 1, 2007, and (3) 21 the member shall not be included in the calculation of the 30% 22 23 under subsection (e) and is not subject to delay in retirement 24 under that subsection. (g) A member who receives any early retirement incentive 25 under Section 17-116.3, 17-116.4, 17-116.5, 17-116.6, or 26 27 17-116.8 may not receive any early retirement incentive under 28 this Section. 29 (40 ILCS 5/17-116.8 new) 30 Sec. 17-116.8. Early retirement incentives. (a) To be eligible for the benefits provided in this 31 32 Section, a person must: (1) be a member of this Fund who, on November 1, 2007, 33 is (i) in active payroll status as a teacher, or (ii) on 34 layoff status from such a position with a right of 35

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1 re-employment or recall to service, or (iii) on leave of 2 absence from such a position, but only if the member on leave has not been receiving a disability benefit under 3 this Article for a continuous period of 2 years or more as 4 5 of the date of application;

(2) be a member of this Fund who, on or after May 1, 2007, is (i) in active payroll status as a teacher, or (ii) on layoff status from such a position with a right of re-employment or recall to service, or (iii) on leave of absence from such a position, but only if the member on leave has not been receiving a disability benefit under this Article for a continuous period of 2 years or more as of the date of application;

(3) have not previously received a retirement pension under this Article;

(4) file with the Board and the Board of Education, 17 before March 1, 2008, a written application requesting the benefits provided in this Section and a notice of 18 resignation from employment, which resignation must take 19 20 effect no earlier than February 1, 2008 and no later than June 30, 2008, unless the applicant's retirement is delayed 21 under subsection (e) or (f) of this Section; 22

(5) be eligible to receive a retirement pension under 23 this Article (for which purpose any age enhancement or 24 25 creditable service received under this Section may be used) and elect to receive the retirement pension beginning no 26 27 earlier than February 1, 2008 and no later than June 30, 2008 or the date established under subsection (e) or (f) of 28 this Section, if applicable; 29

(6) have attained age 50 (without the use of any age enhancement or creditable service received under this Section) by the effective date of the retirement pension;

(7) have at least 5 years of creditable service under 33 this Fund or any of the participating systems under the 34 35 Retirement Systems Reciprocal Act (without the use of any creditable service received under this Section) by the 36

30	(d) An annuitant who has received any age enhancement or			
31	creditable service under this Section and whose pension is			
32	suspended or cancelled under Section 17-149 or 17-150 shall			
33	thereby forfeit the age enhancement and creditable service. The			
34	forfeiture of creditable service under this subsection shall			
35	not entitle the employer to a refund of the employer			
36	contribution paid under this Section, nor to forgiveness of any			

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part of that contribution that remains unpaid. The forfeiture of creditable service under this subsection shall not entitle the employee to a refund of the employee contribution paid under this Section.

5 (e) If the number of employees of an employer that apply 6 for early retirement under this Section exceeds 30% of those eligible, the employer may require that, for any or all of the 7 number of applicants in excess of that 30%, the starting date 8 of the retirement pension enhanced under this Section be no 9 earlier than June 1, 2008 and no later than September 1, 2008. 10 11 The right to have the retirement pension begin before June 1, 12 2008 shall be allocated among the applicants on the basis of seniority in the service of that employer. This delay applies 13 only to persons who are applying for early retirement 14 incentives under this Section, and does not prevent a person 15 16 whose application for early retirement incentives has been 17 withdrawn from beginning to receive a retirement pension on the 18 earliest date upon which the person is otherwise eligible under 19 this Article.

20 (f) For a member who receives notice that he or she has been declared a reserve teacher pursuant to a collective 21 bargaining agreement after January 15, 2008, but before 22 September 15, 2008: (1) the March 1, 2008 application deadline 23 in subdivision (a)(4) of this Section is extended to a date 15 24 days after the date of notification of the reserve teacher 25 declaration, (2) the June 30, 2008 deadline in subdivision 26 27 (a) (5) of this Section is extended to October 1, 2008, and (3) the member shall not be included in the calculation of the 30% 28 under subsection (e) and is not subject to delay in retirement 29 under that subsection. 30

31 (g) A member who receives any early retirement incentive 32 under Section 17-116.3, 17-116.4, 17-116.5, 17-116.6, or 33 <u>17-116.7 may not receive any early retirement incentive under</u> 34 <u>this Section.</u>
