1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4974 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4974 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 4 2-3.136 as follows: (105 ILCS 5/2-3.136) 6 7 Sec. 2-3.136. K-3 class size reduction grant program. A 8 class size reduction grant program is created. The program shall be implemented and administered by the the State Board of 9 Education. From appropriations made for purposes of this 10 Section, the State Board shall award grants to schools that 11 meet the criteria established by this Section for the award of 12 13 those grants. Grants shall be awarded pursuant to application. The form 14 15 and manner of applications and the criteria for the award of 16 grants shall be prescribed by the State Board of Education. The grant criteria as so prescribed, however, shall provide that 17 18 only those schools that are on the State Board of Education Early Academic Warning List or the academic watch list under 19 Section 2-3.25d that maintain grades kindergarten through 3 are 20 21 grant eligible. Grants awarded to eligible schools under this Section shall 22 23 be used and applied by the schools to defray the costs and

expenses of operating and maintaining classes in grades

- kindergarten through 3 with an average class size within a 1
- 2 specific grade of no more than 20 pupils. If a school's
- 3 facilities are inadequate to allow for this specified class
- size, then a school may use the grant funds for teacher aides 4
- 5 instead.
- If a school board determines that a school is using funds
- 7 awarded under this Section for purposes not authorized by this
- Section, then the school board, rather than the school, shall 8
- determine how the funds are used. 9
- The State Board of Education shall adopt any rules, 10
- consistent with the requirements of this Section, that are 11
- necessary to implement and administer the K-3 class size 12
- reduction grant program. 13
