Amends the Illinois Lottery Law. Provides the that term "lottery" does not include any gambling game authorized to be conducted by a licensee under the Riverboat Gambling Act or the Charitable Games Act. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Lottery Law is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1605/3) (from Ch. 120, par. 1153)
- 7 Sec. 3. For the purposes of this Act:
- 8 a. "Lottery" or "State Lottery" means the lottery or
- 9 lotteries established and operated pursuant to this Act.
- 10 "Lottery", however, does not include any gambling game
- 11 <u>authorized to be conducted by a licensee under the Riverboat</u>
- 12 Gambling Act or the Charitable Games Act.
- b. "Board" means the Lottery Control Board created by this
- 14 Act.
- 15 c. "Department" means the Department of the Lottery.
- d. "Director" means the Director of the Department of the
- 17 Lottery.
- e. "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Lottery Control
- 19 Board.
- f. "Multi-state game directors" means such persons,
- 21 including the Director of the Department of the Lottery, as may
- 22 be designated by an agreement between the Department of the
- 23 Lottery and one or more additional lotteries operated under the
- laws of another state or states.
