The amount of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Agriculture for grants, contracts, and administrative expenses associated with the development of the Illinois Grape and Wine Industry, including prior year costs.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2006.
