- 19 employed by U.S. Steel until he retired; he re-entered the
- 20 workforce as a security guard for the City of Chicago and then
- 21 for A.R. Security; and

- lived his life to its fullest; he loved traveling and also
- loved fishing, family gatherings, and politics; he was fondly
- referred to as "Sugarman", "Bill", or "Ghost" by his family,
- friends, and co-workers; and
