HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Heightened interest in television camera coverage 3 of court proceedings has come to the attention of the members 4 of the House of Representatives; and

5 WHEREAS, Many states have experimented with and 6 subsequently found no harm in permitting television cameras in 7 the courtroom; and

8 WHEREAS, The evidence gathered by these states has shown 9 that television coverage does not disrupt the court proceedings 10 or impair the administration of justice; and

11 WHEREAS, Few people understand the workings of the judicial 12 system; television cameras in the courtroom would provide the 13 public with a glimpse of what goes on in the judicial branch of 14 government; and

WHEREAS, Media organizations in Illinois are pushing for expanded use of television cameras in judicial proceedings; therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 19 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 20 we urge the Illinois Supreme Court to develop a pilot program 21 to allow television cameras in courtrooms in the circuit 22 courts; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Illinois.
