- 14 Bloomington Tent and Awning Co. from 1957 to 2002; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Bradley was elected Democratic State
- Representative in the 44th District of Illinois in 1969 and
- served seven terms until 1982; he served as a majority whip in
- 18 Springfield for several years; and
- 19 WHEREAS, He was chairman of the board of First Federal
- 20 Savings and Loan, Bloomington, and served on the board of OSF
- 21 St. Joseph Medical Center, Bloomington, and he was a member of
- 22 Holy Trinity Catholic Church, Bloomington; and
- WHEREAS, The passing of Gerald A. Bradley has been deeply
- 24 felt by many, especially his daughters, Katie (Robert) Stotler
- 25 and Margaret Lehman; his sons, David (Carolyn) Bradley and
