The Mobile Home Park Act is amended by adding Sections 2.7a and 2.7b and changing Sections 9.3, 9.9, and 26 5 6 as follows: 7 (210 ILCS 115/2.7a new) Sec. 2.7a. "Existing site" means a parcel of land for the 8 accommodation of a mobile home constructed before the effective 9 date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly and 10 built in conformance with the standards in effect at the time 11 the site was originally constructed. 12 13 (210 ILCS 115/2.7b new) Sec. 2.7b. "New site" means a parcel of land for the 14 15 accommodation of a mobile home constructed on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General 16 17 Assembly. (210 ILCS 115/9.3) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 719.3) 18 19 Sec. 9.3. Minimum sites; access. (a) Each site on which a mobile home is accommodated shall 20 have a minimum area of 2,500 square feet, provided that sites 21 22 existing in parks or approved by the Department for

- construction prior to August 21, 1967, shall contain an area of 1
- 2 not less than 1,000 square feet, and sites constructed between
- 3 August 21, 1967 and September 18, 1987 the effective date of
- this amendatory Act of 1987 shall contain an area of not less 4
- 5 than 2,100 feet.
- (b) No mobile home shall be parked closer than 5 feet to 6
- 7 the side lot lines of a park, or closer than 10 feet to a public
- 8 street, alley, or building. Each individual site shall abut or
- 9 face on a private or public street. All streets shall have
- unobstructed access to a public street. There shall be an open 10
- space of at least 10 feet adjacent to the sides of every mobile 11
- home and at least 5 feet adjacent to the ends of every mobile 12
- 13 home.
- (c) When a mobile home is removed from an existing site and 14
- 15 then returned to the existing site or when a mobile home on an
- 16 existing site is removed from the site and replaced by another
- mobile home on the existing site, the existing site shall not 17
- be deemed to be a new site and shall be governed by the 18
- standards in effect at the time the site was originally 19
- 20 constructed.
- 21 (d) A home rule unit other than a home rule municipality
- 22 with a population greater than 1,000,000 may not regulate new
- or existing mobile home sites, as defined in this Act, with 23
- 24 respect to setback and separation requirements or minimum
- 25 square-footage standards in a manner that conflicts with this
- 26 Section. This subsection is a limitation under subsection (i)
- of Section 6 of Article <u>VII of the Illinois Constitution on the</u> 27
- 28 concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and functions
- 29 exercised by the State.

- 32 Sec. 9.9. Fire extinguishers; smoke and carbon monoxide
- 33 detectors.

- (a) Mobile homes in mobile home parks shall each be 1 equipped with the following: 2
- 3 (1) Fire fire extinguishers in working order, one in 4 each end of the mobile home.
- 5 (2) A smoke detector, in working order, in each bedroom in the mobile home, in accordance with standards approved 6 7 by the State Fire Marshal.
- (3) A carbon monoxide detector in working order, in 8 accordance with standards approved by the State Fire 9 Marshal. 10
- (b) Inspection of any such equipment and enforcement of any 11 Rules and Regulations adopted pursuant to this Section 12 paragraph shall be the duty of the State Fire Marshall and 13 local law enforcement agencies in the county or municipality 14 15 where the mobile home park is located.
- (c) The changes made to this Section 9.9 by this amendatory 16 Act of the 94th General Assembly apply on and after the date 17 that occurs one year after this amendatory Act of the 94th 18 General Assembly becomes law. 19
