3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
5	changing Section 30-30 and by adding Section 30-31 as follows:

7	Sec. 30-30. <u>Projects</u> Contracts in excess of <u>\$750,000</u>
8	\$250,000 . For building construction <u>projects</u> contracts in
9	excess of <u>\$750,000</u> \$250,000 , separate specifications shall be
10	prepared for all equipment, labor, and materials in connection
11	with the following 5 subdivisions of the work to be performed:
12	<pre>(1) plumbing;</pre>
13	(2) heating, piping, refrigeration, and automatic
14	temperature control systems, including the testing and
15	balancing of those systems;
16	(3) ventilating and distribution systems for
17	conditioned air, including the testing and balancing of
18	those systems;
19	(4) electric wiring; and
20	(5) general contract work.
21	The specifications must be so drawn as to permit separate
22	and independent bidding upon each of the 5 subdivisions of
23	work. All contracts awarded for any part thereof shall award
24	the 5 subdivisions of work separately to responsible and

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1 reliable persons, firms, or corporations engaged in these classes of work. The contracts, at the discretion of the 2 3 construction agency, may be assigned to the successful bidder 4 on the general contract work or to the successful bidder on the 5 subdivision of work designated by the construction agency before the bidding as the prime subdivision of work, provided 6 7 that all payments will be made directly to the contractors for 8 the 5 subdivisions of work upon compliance with the conditions of the contract. A contract may be let for one or more 9 10 in any project to the same contractor. buildings The 11 specifications shall require, however, that unless the buildings are identical, a separate price shall be submitted 12 13 for each building. The contract may be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder for each or all of the buildings included in 14 15 the specifications.

Notwithstanding the requirements of this Section, if the contract for work to be performed in any one of the 5 subdivisions is less than \$200,000, then the contract for that subdivision need not be separately awarded but may be incorporated into one or more of the remaining contracts.

21 Until a date 2 years after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly, the requirements 22 23 of this Section do not apply to the construction of an 24 Emergency Operations Center for the Illinois Emergency 25 Management Agency if (i) the majority of the funding for the 26 project is from federal funds, (ii) the bid of the successful bidder identifies the name of the subcontractor, if any, and 27 28 the bid proposal costs for each of the 5 subdivisions of work 29 set forth in this Section, and (iii) the contract entered into with the successful bidder provides that no identified 30 31 subcontractor may be terminated without the written consent of 32 the Capital Development Board.

2	Sec. 30-31. Construction projects of \$750,000 or less. For
3	building construction projects of \$750,000 or less, (i) the
4	successful bidder must identify the name of the subcontractor,
5	if any, and the bid proposal cost for each of the 5
6	subdivisions of work set forth in Section 30-30 and (ii) the
7	contract entered into with the successful bidder shall provide
8	that no identified responsive and responsible subcontractor
9	who provides a bid bond may be terminated without the written
10	consent of the Capital Development Board.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 becoming law.".
