A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
7 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the  
8 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent  
9 expenses:

26 Section 10. The sum of \$338,699,800, or so much thereof  
27 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
28 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for  
29 payment of grant awards to students eligible to receive such  
30 awards, as provided by law.

1 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
 3 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student  
 4 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

5 Grants and Scholarships

6 For payment of matching grants to Illinois  
 7 institutions to supplement scholarship  
 8 programs, as provided by law .....950,000

9 For payment of Merit Recognition Scholarships  
 10 to undergraduate students under the Merit  
 11 Recognition Scholarship Program provided  
 12 for in Section 31 of the Higher Education  
 13 Student Assistance Act .....5,400,000

14 For the payment of scholarships to students  
 15 who are children of policemen or firemen  
 16 killed in the line of duty, or who are  
 17 dependents of correctional officers killed  
 18 or permanently disabled in the line of  
 19 duty, as provided by law .....350,000

20 For payment of Illinois National Guard and  
 21 Naval Militia Scholarships at  
 22 State-controlled universities and public  
 23 community colleges in Illinois to students  
 24 eligible to receive such awards, as  
 25 provided by law .....4,480,000

26 For payment of military Veterans' scholarships  
 27 at State-controlled universities and at  
 28 public community colleges for students  
 29 eligible, as provided by law .....19,250,000

30 For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships .....3,100,000

31 For payment of Illinois Scholars Scholarships .....3,020,000

32 For payment of Illinois Incentive for Access  
 33 grants, as provided by law .....7,200,000

2 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
4 Illinois National Guard Grant Fund to the Illinois Student  
5 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

6 Grants and Scholarships

7 For payment of Illinois National Guard

8 Naval Militia Scholarships

9 at State-controlled universities

10 and public community colleges in

11 Illinois to students eligible to

12 receive such awards, as provided by law .....20,000

13 Section 25. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the  
16 Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

17 Section 30. The following named amount, or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
19 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
20 for the following purpose:

21 Grants and Scholarships

22 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher

23 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law .....4,100,000

24 Section 35. The following named amount, or so much  
25 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
26 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
27 Commission for the following purpose:

28 To support outreach, research, and

29 training activities .....70,000

1 Section 40. The following named amount, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 3 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the  
 4 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
 5 purpose:

6 Grants and Scholarships

7 For payment of scholarships for the

8 Optometric Education Scholarship

9 Program, as provided by law .....50,000

10 Section 45. The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof  
 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
 12 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for  
 13 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for  
 14 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection  
 15 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under  
 16 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for  
 17 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default  
 18 Aversion Fees, and for other distributions as necessary and  
 19 provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

20 Section 50. The sum of \$21,334,400, or so much thereof  
 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
 22 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund  
 23 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment  
 24 of collection agency fees associated with collection  
 25 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default  
 26 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary  
 27 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

28 Section 55. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 29 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
 30 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund

1 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and  
2 Maintenance.

3 Section 60. The sum of \$300,000, or so much of that  
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts  
5 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
6 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent  
7 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection  
8 Act of 1986.

9 Section 65. The following named amount, or so much  
10 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
11 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student  
12 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

13 For payment of Robert C. Byrd  
14 Honors Scholarships .....1,800,000

15 Section 70. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
17 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for  
18 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate  
19 Program, as provided by law.

20 Section 75. The following named amount, or so much  
21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
22 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student  
23 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

24 For transferring repayment funds collected  
25 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship  
26 Program to the U.S. Treasury ..... 400,000

27 Section 80. The following named amount, or so much  
28 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
29 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the

1 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
2 purpose:

For payment of scholarships for the

3 Illinois Future Teacher Corps

4 Scholarship Program as provided by law .....60,000

5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
6 2005.
