1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board  
8 of the Trustees of Illinois State University to meet ordinary  
9 and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
10 2006:
