SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 90/35

Amends the Health Care Workplace Violence Prevention Act. Increases the membership of the pilot project task force from 6 to 10, adding one representative of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees; one representative of the Illinois Federation of Public Employees; and 2 representatives of the Department of Human Services, one representing the Division of Mental Health and the other representing the Division of Developmental Disabilities. Effective immediately.

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FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1

AN ACT concerning health.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Health Care Workplace Violence Prevention
 Act is amended by changing Section 35 as follows:
- 6 (405 ILCS 90/35)

7 Sec. 35. Pilot project; task force.

8 (a) The Department of Human Services and the Department of 9 Public Health shall initially implement this Act as a 2-year 10 pilot project in which only the following health care 11 workplaces shall participate:

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(1) The Chester Mental Health Center.

- (2) The Alton Mental Health Center.
- 14 (3) The Douglas Singer Mental Health Center.
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(4) The Andrew McFarland Mental Health Center.

(5) The Jacksonville Developmental Center.

Each health care workplace participating in the pilotproject shall comply with this Act as provided in this Act.

19 (b) The Governor shall convene a 10-member 6-member task force consisting of the following: one member appointed by the 20 21 President of the Senate; one member appointed by the Minority 22 Leader of the Senate; one member appointed by the Speaker of 23 House of Representatives; one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; one representative from 24 25 statewide association representing licensed registered а 26 professional nurses; <u>one representative of the American</u> Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees; one 27 representative of the Illinois Federation of Public Employees; 28 and 3 representatives of the Department of Human Services, with 29 30 one representative from the Division of Mental Health and one representative from the Division of Developmental Disabilities 31 of and one representative from the Department of Human 32

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1 Services. The task force shall submit a report to the Illinois 2 General Assembly by January 1, 2008 that shall (i) evaluate the 3 effectiveness of the health care workplace violence prevention 4 pilot project in the facilities participating in the pilot 5 project and (ii) make recommendations concerning the 6 implementation of workplace violence prevention programs in 7 all health care workplaces.
