Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 9 (a) A K-3 class size reduction grant program is created.
- 10 The program shall be implemented and administered by the State
- 11 Board of Education. From appropriations made for purposes of
- 12 this Section, the State Board shall award grants to schools
- that meet the criteria established by this <u>subsection</u> (a)
- 14 Section for the award of those grants.
- Grants shall be awarded pursuant to application. The form
- 16 and manner of applications and the criteria for the award of
- grants shall be prescribed by the State Board of Education. The
- grant criteria as so prescribed, however, shall provide that
- only those schools that are on the State Board of Education
- 20 Early Academic Warning List or the academic watch list under
- 21 Section 2-3.25d that maintain grades kindergarten through 3 are

- Grants awarded to eligible schools under this <u>subsection</u>

- 14 <u>(c)</u> If a school board determines that a school is using
- 15 funds awarded under this Section for purposes not authorized by
- 16 this Section, then the school board, rather than the school,
- shall determine how the funds are used.
- 18 (d) The State Board of Education shall adopt any rules,
