AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$15,000,000, or so much of that 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Capital Development Board for grants for 7 architectural and engineering studies and construction of a 8 cooperative high school in Vermilion County involving Jamaica 9 High School, Oakwood High School, and Catlin High School.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2007.
