(a) A In a proceeding under this Article, a minor who was 8 9 under 17 $\frac{13}{13}$ years of age at the time of the commission of an act that if committed by an adult would be a violation of Section 10 9-1, 9-1.2, 9-2, 9-2.1, 9-3, 9-3.2, 9-3.3, 12-13, 12-14, 11 12-14.1, 12-15, or 12-16 of the Criminal Code of 1961 must be 12 represented by counsel during the 13 entire custodial 14 interrogation of the minor.

(b) In a judicial proceeding under this Article, a minor may not waive the right to the assistance of counsel in his or her defense.
