Amends the Pharmacy Practice Act of 1987. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning licensure without examination.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Pharmacy Practice Act of 1987 is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 85/8) (from Ch. 111, par. 4128)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2008)
- Sec. 8. <u>The</u> Department may, in its discretion, license 9 as a pharmacist, without examination, on payment of the
- 10 required fee, an applicant who is so licensed under the laws of
- 11 another U.S. jurisdiction or another country, if the
- 12 requirements for licensure in the other jurisdiction in which
- the applicant was licensed, were, at the date of his licensure
- 14 deemed by the Board to be substantially equivalent to the
- requirements then in force in this State.
