AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

4 5 ARTICLE 1 Section 5. The sum of \$358,000,000, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services in 8 9 support of The Illinois Covered Initiative. 10 Section 10. The sum of \$16,000,000, or so much thereof 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 12 Fund to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to 13 14 provide grants for healthcare system improvements. 15 16 Section 15. The sum of \$90,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 17 Fund to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services for 18

19 expenses related to or arising from medical practitioner rate 20 increases.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007. 22
