AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of 5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the 6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General 7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender:

1 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much of 2 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are 3 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of 4 the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent 5 expenses of the Post Conviction Unit:

18 Section 15. The following named amounts, so much of 19 those amounts, as may be necessary, respectively, for the 20 objects and purposes named, are appropriated to the office 21 of the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to 22 federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing 23 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed:

3 Section 20. The amount of \$3,190,453, or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital 5 Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate 6 Defender for expenses incurred in providing assistance to 7 trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section 10 of the State 8 Appellate Defender Act.

9 Section 25. The amount of \$250,200, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Funds 11 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the 12 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

Section 30. The amount of \$40,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Funds to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training Program.

18 Section 35. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Funds 20 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to enhance the 21 capability of public defenders in rural counties, to HB3836 -4- LRB095 11581 RLC 33315 b effectively represent their clients in appropriate cases, and to make available to them expert witnesses and investigative services under the Rural Public Defender Services Program.
