The amount of \$2,380,400, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment General 11 12 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use, subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in 13 the performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the 14 15 duties of the Attorney General, including State law 16 enforcement and public education.

Section 25. 1 Section 30. The amount of \$1,066,000, or so much thereof 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney 3 General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the 4 Office of the Attorney General for State law enforcement 5 purposes.

6 Section 35. The amount of \$450,000, or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital 8 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial 9 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.

The amount of \$378,300, or so much thereof 10 Section 40. 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the 12 funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and 13 14 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris, 15 16 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act, 17 and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation. 18

6 Section 50. The amount of \$2,500, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's 8 Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to be 9 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon 10 which those funds were received.

11 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much 12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 13 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the 14 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses 15 of the Attorney General:

1 Section 60. The amount of \$125,600, or so much thereof 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support 3 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for 4 child support enforcement purposes.

5 Section 65. The amount of \$921,600, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney 7 General Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney 8 General for funding for federal grants.

9 Section 70. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender 10 Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board 11 for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management 12 Board Act including, but not limited to, sex offender 13 evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants. 14 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in 15 16 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the funding. 17

18 Section 75. The amount of \$25,000, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide Grand 20 Jury Prosecution Fund to the Office of the Attorney General 21 for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under 22 the Statewide Grand Jury Act.
