SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-709.1

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-709.1

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the restrictions on driving a vehicle on the shoulder of a highway do not apply to any farm tractor or implement of husbandry. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 11-709.1 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-709.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-709.1)
- 7 Sec. 11-709.1. <u>Driving on the shoulder.</u>
- 8 (a) Vehicles shall be driven on a roadway, and shall only
- 9 be driven on the shoulder for the purpose of stopping or
- 10 accelerating from a stop while merging into traffic. It shall
- 11 be a violation of this Section if while merging into traffic
- 12 and while on the shoulder, the vehicle passes any other vehicle
- on the roadway adjacent to it.
- 14 (b) This Section shall not apply to any authorized
- 15 emergency vehicle, to any farm tractor or implement of
- 16 husbandry, or to any service vehicle while engaged in
- maintenance of the highway or related work.

- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
