SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 60/54.8 new

Amends the Medical Practice Act of 1987. Provides that a Board-certified plastic surgeon shall be the only individuals permitted to perform laser surgeries, Botox injections, or chemical peels on patients. Provides that a Board-certified plastic surgeon may not delegate the performance of the procedures any other other individual. Provides that a violation of the specified provisions that results, directly or indirectly, in the death of a patient is punishable as a Class 1 felony with a minimum prison term of 10 years.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended by adding Section 54.8 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 60/54.8 new)
- Sec. 54.8. Procedures to be conducted by Board-certified plastic surgeons.
- 9 <u>(a) For purposes of this Section, "Board-certified plastic</u>
 10 <u>surgeon" means a physician that has been certified by the</u>
 11 American Board of Plastic Surgery.
- 12 <u>(b) A Board-certified plastic surgeon shall be the only</u>
 13 <u>individuals permitted to perform laser surgeries, Botox</u>
 14 <u>injections, or chemical peels on patients. The Board-certified</u>
 15 <u>plastic surgeon may not delegate the performance of these</u>
 16 procedures any other other individual.
- (c) A violation of this Section that results, directly or indirectly, in the death of a patient is punishable as a Class

 1 felony with a minimum prison term of 10 years.
