SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 5/7.6 new

Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that all recycling centers within the State must require individuals who recycle copper to present a valid driver's license or State-issued identification card at the time of the transaction and must maintain a log of all copper recycling transactions. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by 5 adding Section 7.6 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 5/7.6 new) 7 <u>Sec. 7.6. Copper recycling. All recycling centers within</u> 8 <u>the State must require individuals who recycle copper to</u> 9 <u>present a valid driver's license or State-issued</u> 10 <u>identification card at the time of the transaction. All</u> 11 <u>recycling centers within the State must maintain a log of</u> 12 <u>copper recycling transactions.</u>

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
