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1 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the 2 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General 3 Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 4 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action 5 in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 6 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 7 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 8 9 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of 10 the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative 11 Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 12 13 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois 14 Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such 15 definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 16 jurisdiction of the Governor".
