2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- 4 Section 5. The Respite Program Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (320 ILCS 10/5) (from Ch. 23, par. 6205)
- 7 Sec. 5. Eligibility. <u>The</u> Department may establish
- 8 eligibility standards for respite services taking into
- 9 consideration the unique economic and social needs of the
- 10 population for whom they are to be provided. The population
- 11 identified for the purposes of this Act includes persons
- 12 suffering from Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder and
- persons who are 60 years of age or older with an identified
- service need. Priority shall be given in all cases to frail or
- disabled adults.
