4 Section 5. The Illinois Power Agency Act is amended by 5 adding Section 1-128 as follows:

Sec. 1-128. Renewable energy program. The Agency shall, in
conjunction with the Department of Commerce and Economic
Opportunity, develop a program to promote renewable energy and
net-metering options in the State.

Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may 11 12 exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or 13 14 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this Section. If, however, the Governor believes that rules are 15 16 necessary to implement or enforce the provisions of this 17 Section, the Governor may suggest rules to the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the Secretary of 18 19 the Senate and by requesting that the General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those suggested rules 20 21 into law, or take any other appropriate action in the General 22 Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this Section shall be interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 23
