1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6024

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6024, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
8 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named to meet the
9 ordinary and contingent expenses of the State Employees'
10 Retirement System:

16 Section 10. The sum of \$59,983,000, or so much thereof
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 18 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement
 19 System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.

20 Section 15. The sum of \$8,847,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 22 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly
 23 Retirement System for the State's Contribution, as provided

1 by law.

2 ARTICLE 2

3 Section 5. The sum of \$3,916,338, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
5 Assistance Fund to the State Universities Retirement System
6 for deposit into the Community College Health Insurance
7 Security Fund for the State's contribution, as required by
8 law.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$200,523,900, minus the amount
10 transferred to the State Universities Retirement System
11 pursuant to continuing appropriation authorized by the State
12 Pensions Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated
13 from the State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
14 State Universities Retirement System of Illinois pursuant to
15 the provisions of Section 8.12 of "AN ACT in relation to
16 State finance", approved June 10, 1919, as amended.

17 Section 15. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the Board
19 of Trustees of the State Universities Retirement System for
20 the State's contribution, as provided by law:

21 Payable from the Education Assistance Fund.....249,692,100

1 ARTICLE 3

2 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
4 Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois for the
5 State's contributions, as provided by law:

6 Payable from the Common School Fund1,449,889,000

7 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated
9 from the Education Assistance Fund to the Teachers'
10 Retirement System for the objects and purposes hereinafter
11 named:

12 For additional costs due to the establishment
13 of minimum retirement allowances
14 pursuant to Sections 16-136.2 and
15 16-136.3 of the "Illinois
16 Pension Code", as amended1,900,000

17 ARTICLE 4

18 Section 5. The amount of \$65,044,700, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
20 Assistance Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and

1 Retirement Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for
2 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008.

3 Section 10. The amount of \$9,800,000, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
5 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement
6 Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for retirement
7 contributions under Section 17-127 of the Pension Code for
8 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008.

9 Section 15. The amount of \$75,474,000, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
11 Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the
12 State of Illinois for transfer into the Teachers' Health
13 Insurance Security Fund as the state's contribution for
14 teachers' health insurance.

15 ARTICLE 999

16 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
17 1, 2008."
