1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6361

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6361, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Comptroller to meet
10 its ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year
11 ending June 30, 2009:

- 12 For Expenses of Local Government
- 13 Officials Training12,500
- 14 For Contractual Services for auditing

3 ARTICLE 2

4 Section 5. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Court of Claims for payment of awards
7 solely as a result of the lapsing of an appropriation
8 originally made from any funds held by the State Treasurer.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$13,000,000 or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Court of Claims for payment of line of duty
12 awards.
