1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6542

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6542, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 Fund to the Department of Public Health for expenses targeted
9 to decrease health disparities in communities of color for
10 Breast and Cervical Cancer.

11 Section 11. The sum of \$2,750,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Department of Public Health for distribution of

1 medical education scholarships authorized by An Act to
 2 provide grants for family practice residency programs and
 3 medical student scholarships through the Illinois Department
 4 of Public Health.

5 Section 15. The following named amount, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the
 7 Department of Public Health from the Public Health Services
