AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6566, by deleting everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

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Section 80. 5 Section 35. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Cigarette Fire Safety 7 Standard Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the 8 purpose of fire safety and prevention programs.

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#### ARTICLE 5

10 Section 5. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Violence 20 Prevention Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority 21 for the purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of 09500HB6566ham001 -10- HDS095 00235 CIN 20235 a the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

2 Section 10. The sum of \$2,127,500, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority for the 5 purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of the 6 Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

7 Section 15. The amount of \$526,500, or so much of that 8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 9 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority 10 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council 11 Program.

12 Section 20. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 14 Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority for all 15 costs associated with Bullying Prevention.
