2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 4, AS AMENDED, with
3 reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No. 1,
4 on page 5, by inserting immediately below line 21 the
5 following:

6 "(h) All Institute information concerning medical research
7 shall be confidential and privileged and not subject to
8 disclosure to any person other than Institute personnel."; and

9 on page 6, by inserting immediately below line 14 the
10 following:

11 "(c) A member of a scientific peer review panel or any
12 other advisory committee that may be established by the
13 Department who has a conflict of interest with respect to a
14 matter may not discuss that matter with other peer review panel
15 or advisory committee members or with Committee members and
16 shall not vote or otherwise participate in any peer review
17 panel or advisory committee action with respect to that matter.

1 Each recusal of a peer review panel or advisory committee
2 member occurring during a peer review panel or advisory
3 committee meeting shall be made a part of the minutes or
4 recording of the meeting in accordance with the Open Meetings
5 Act."; and

6 on page 6, line 15, by changing "(c)" to "(d)"; and

7 on page 6, by replacing lines 19 through 21 with the following:

8 "Section 30. Disclosure of Committee, scientific peer
9 review panel, or advisory committee member income and
10 interests.

11 (a) Each Committee, scientific peer review panel, and any
12 advisory committee member shall file with the Secretary of";

14 on page 7, line 12, by inserting after "member" the following:
15 "and each member of a scientific peer review panel and any
16 advisory committee member"; and

17 on page 7, line 16, by inserting after "member" the following:
18 "and each member of a scientific peer review panel and any
19 advisory committee member"; and

20 on page 8, by replacing line 24 with the following:

1 "4 felony for the first conviction and a Class 1 felony for".
