SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-610.1

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Prohibits a person under the age of 19 years (instead of 18 years) who holds an instruction permit or a graduated license from driving on a roadway while using a wireless phone, except for emergency purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing 5 Section 12-610.1 as follows:

(625 ILCS 5/12-610.1) 6

7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.

(a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a 8 9 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic communications without a wire connecting the device to the 10 11 telephone network.

(b) A person under the age of 19 18 years who holds an 12 instruction permit issued under Section 6-105 or 6-107.1, or a 13 14 person under the age of $\frac{19}{18}$ years who holds a graduated license issued under Section 6-107, may not drive a vehicle on 15 16 a roadway while using a wireless phone.

17 (c) This Section does not apply to a person under the age of 19 18 years using a wireless telephone for emergency 18 19 purposes, including, but not limited to, an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, 20 21 or other emergency services agency or entity.
