## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

  Section 12-610.1 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a
  9 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic
  10 communications without a wire connecting the device to the
- 11 telephone network.
- 12 (b) A person under the age of  $\underline{19}$   $\underline{18}$  years who holds an
- instruction permit issued under Section 6-105 or 6-107.1, or a
- 14 person under the age of  $\underline{19}$   $\underline{18}$  years who holds a graduated
- 15 license issued under Section 6-107, may not drive a vehicle on
- a roadway while using a wireless phone.
- 17 (c) This Section does not apply to a person under the age
- of 19 <del>18</del> years using a wireless telephone for emergency
- 19 purposes, including, but not limited to, an emergency call to a
- law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department,
- or other emergency services agency or entity.
