2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended
 by changing Section 12 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/12) (from Ch. 23, par. 5012)

7 Sec. 12. (a) provide То supervision, housing 8 accommodations, board or the payment of boarding costs, 9 tuition, and treatment free of charge, except as otherwise specified in this Act, for residents of this State who are 10 cared for in any institution, or for persons receiving services 11 under any program under the jurisdiction of the Department. 12 13 Residents of other states may be admitted upon payment of the 14 costs of board, tuition, and treatment as determined by the Department; provided, that no resident of another state shall 15 16 be received or retained to the exclusion of any resident of 17 this State. The Department shall accept any donation for the board, tuition, and treatment of any person receiving service 18 19 or care.

(b) To By July 1, 1994, to make room and board payments to
persons providing foster care under this Act at a rate for each
child that is up to 100% of the adjusted United States
