- Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 3A-16 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 3A-16. Regional office of education advisory board.
- (a) Beginning October 1, 2009 April 1, 1995, a regional 8 9 office of education advisory board shall be established within each region serving Class I counties or within each group of 10 regions participating in an intergovernmental agreement for 11 12 the provision of professional development to advise regional superintendent of schools of the region or regions 13 14 involved concerning the planning and delivery of professional development programs and services under Section 2 3.62 and 15 16 other programs under the control of the regional superintendent 17 of schools.
 - (b) The advisory board shall consist of at least 9 the following 13 members. All members of the advisory board shall be certified pursuant to Article 21 of this Code and be currently employed in positions requiring certification by a school district, special education cooperative, joint agreement, or regional office of education program. - (1) 7 public members, at least one from each county in the region, selected by the presidents of the region's school parent groups at a meeting held each April. Public members shall be geographically balanced throughout the region. Public members shall meet the same criteria as of local boards of education but shall not members of a local board of education or school district employees.
- (2) 4 teachers, none of whom shall be from the same school district, nominated and selected by all the teachers in the region.
- (3) 2 administrators, from different school districts, nominated and selected by all the administrators in the region.
- Members of the advisory board shall serve 4-year terms, except that of the initial members, 5 shall serve until April 30, 1996, 4 shall serve until April 30, 1997, and 4 shall serve until April 30, 1998, as determined by lot.
 - (c) The regional office of education advisory board shall

- 2 performance of its advisory duties under Section 3-11 and
- 3 subsection (a) of this Section 3A-16.
