## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/6-210.4 new 30 ILCS 805/8.33 new

Amends the Chicago Firefighters Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Allows an active fireman to establish a maximum of 24 months of additional service credit attributed to service in the armed forces of the United States that was served prior to employment by the city as a firefighter. Requires contribution of employee contributions and employer contributions, plus interest. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding Section 6-210.4 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/6-210.4 new)
- 7 Sec. 6-210.4. Creditable service for pre-employment military service. An active fireman may establish a maximum of 8 9 24 months of additional service credit attributed to service in 10 the armed forces of the United States that was served prior to employment by the city as a firefighter by applying in writing 11 12 to the fund and, after substantiation of any such requested service, making contributions to the fund equal to (i) the 13 14 employee contributions that would have been required had the service been rendered as a member, plus (ii) an amount 15 determined by the fund to be equal to the employer's normal 16 17 cost of the benefits accrued for that military service, plus (iii) interest at the actuarially assumed rate provided in the 18 19 Fund's most recent annual actuarial valuation, compounded annually from the first date of membership in the fund to the 20 21 date of payment on items (i) and (ii).
- 22 <u>This Section applies only to firemen in service on or after</u> 23 its effective date.

- 4 Sec. 8.33. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- 6 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
- 7 <u>the 96th General Assembly.</u>
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.
