AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$14,095,597, or so much of that 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education for grants to 7 those 46 school districts in this State that have school 8 service employees employed by private contractors to pay for 9 a \$1 raise for each of these employees as well as health 10 insurance for these employees.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
