A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General
7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender.

1 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much of
 2 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are
 3 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of
 4 the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent
 5 expenses of the Capital Post-Conviction Unit.

19 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much of
 20 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the
 21 objects and purposes named, are appropriated to the Office
 22 of the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to
 23 federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing
 24 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed.

1	Payable from State Appellate Defender Federal	
2	Trust Fund	210,000
3	Matching Funds payable from the General Revenue	
4	Fund	64,000

5 Section 20. The following named amount, \$3,230,213, or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from
7 the Capital Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State
8 Appellate Defender for expenses incurred in providing
9 assistance to trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section
10 10 of the State Appellate Defender Act.

11 Section 25. The following named amount, \$277,000, or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
13 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate
14 Defender for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
15 Expungement Program.

16 Section 30. The following named amount, \$40,000, or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
18 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate
19 Defender to provide statewide training to Public Defenders
20 under the Public Defender Training Program.

21 Section 35. The following named amount, \$350,000, or so

1 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
2 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate
3 Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

4 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
5 1, 2009.
