1 Section 255. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State 3 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to 4 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public 5 and private schools within Illinois.

6 Section 260. The amount of \$3,000, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State 8 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the 9 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl 10 Scouts of the U.S.A.

11 Section 265. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State 13 from the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois 14 Support Our Troops, Inc for charitable assistance to the 15 troops and their families in accordance with its Articles of 16 Incorporation.

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18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,19 2009.

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
