1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-689 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-689 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-689. The Prairie State license plates.</u>
- (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 8 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may 10 issue special registration plates designated as The Prairie State license plates. The special plates issued under this 11 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 12 first division or motor vehicles of the second division 13 14 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure 15 16 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
- 17 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
 18 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
 19 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany
 20 each application. The Secretary may allow the plates to be
 21 issued as vanity plates or personalized plates under Section
 22 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or
- 23 <u>decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.</u>
