1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-684 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-684 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-684. State University Police license plates.</u>
- 8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of a request from a 9 university in this State, accompanied by an application and the appropriate fee, may issue, to a State university police force, 10 special registration plates designated as State University 11 12 Police license plates. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 13 14 first division or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, owned by a State 15 16 university or State university police force. Plates issued 17 under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 18
 - (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The plates are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln" as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary may prescribe rules governing the requirements and approval of the
