2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4927, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No.  
4 2, on page 14, by replacing lines 3 and 4 with "with or  
5 recognized by the State Board of Education."; and

6 on page 18, by replacing lines 21 and 22 with "~~issued prior to~~  
7 ~~the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General~~  
8 ~~Assembly shall~~"; and

9 on page 23, line 22, after the period, by inserting "A licensed  
10 fraternal establishment or licensed veterans establishment  
11 that does not hold a liquor license may operate video gaming  
12 terminals if (i) the establishment is located in a county with  
13 a population between 6,500 and 7,000, based on the 2000 U.S.  
14 Census, (ii) the county prohibits by ordinance the sale of  
15 alcohol, and (iii) the establishment is in a portion of the  
16 county where the sale of alcohol is prohibited.".
