1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5243 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5243 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is 4 amended by adding Section 26 as follows: 5 6 (215 ILCS 106/26 new) 7 Sec. 26. Moratorium on eligibility. Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General 8 Assembly, there shall be a 2-year moratorium on the expansion 9 10 of eligibility under the Program through increasing financial 11 eligibility standards beyond those in place February 1, 2010. Eliqibility may be expanded only if authorized by a 3/5 vote in 12 both the House and Senate. This moratorium shall not apply to 13 expansions required by federal law. 14

Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is

- 8 Eligibility may be expanded only if authorized by a 3/5 vote in
- 9 both the House and Senate. This moratorium shall not apply to
- 10 expansions required by federal law.
- 11 Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- adding Section 5-1.3 as follows: 12
- 13 (305 ILCS 5/5-1.3 new)
- Sec. 5-1.3. Moratorium on eligibility and program 14
- expansions. Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory 15
- Act of the 96th General Assembly, there shall be a 2-year 16
- 17 moratorium on the expansion of eligibility through increasing
- 18 financial eligibility standards or the creation of new programs
- 19 which would add new categories of eligible individuals under
- 20 the medical assistance program under this Article in addition
- 21 to those categories covered on February 1, 2010. Eligibility
- 22 may be expanded only if authorized by a 3/5 vote in both the
- 23 House and Senate. This moratorium shall not apply to expansions

- 1 required by federal law.
- 2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 3 becoming law.".
