The Rights of Crime Victims and Witnesses Act 4 is amended by adding Section 6.5 as follows: 5 6 (725 ILCS 120/6.5 new) 7 Sec. 6.5. Minors under 18 years of age; guardian ad litem. In any case in which a minor under 18 years of age is the 8 alleged victim or witness of a violent crime, the court may 10 appoint a quardian ad litem for the minor if the court finds 11 that there is a conflict between the minor and his or her 12 parents, quardian, or other custodian or that it is otherwise in the minor's best interest that a quardian ad litem be 13
