2 Section 25. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants 4 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under 5 the terms and conditions associated with the federal 6 contracts and grants moneys received.

Section 30. The sum of \$1,640,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

Section 35. The sum of \$1,230,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of higher education.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$880,000, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 19 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants 20 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating 21 nurses. HB6753

5 Section 50. The sum of \$230,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated 8 with the u.Select System.

9 Section 55. The sum of \$205,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated 12 with the Integrated P-20 Student Information System.

13 Section 60. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College 15 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher 16 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses 17 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110 18 ILCS 1005.

Section 65. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality HB6753 -5- OMB096 00386 DPC 10387 b Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.
