A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal
9 Justice Information Authority:

20 Section 20. The additional sum of \$500,000, or so much
 21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 22 Criminal Justice Information Trust Fund to the Illinois

1 Criminal Justice Information Authority for Crime Victims
2 Assistance awards and grants to local units of government and
3 non-profit organizations in accordance with applicable laws
4 and regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
5 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
6 2009.

7 Section 25. The additional sum of \$4,600,000, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
9 Criminal Justice Information Trust Fund to the Illinois
10 Criminal Justice Information Authority for Violence Against
11 Women awards and grants to local units of government and non-
12 profit organizations in accordance with applicable laws and
13 regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
14 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
15 2009.

16 Section 30. The additional sum of \$23,000,000, or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
18 Criminal Justice Information Trust Fund to the Illinois
19 Criminal Justice Information Authority for Byrne/JAG awards
20 and grants to local units of government and non-profit
21 organizations in accordance with applicable laws and
22 regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
23 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of

1 2009.

2 Section 35. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
4 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
5 Information Authority for awards and grants to state
6 agencies.

7 Section 40. The additional sum of \$0, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
9 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
10 Information Authority for Crime Victims Assistance awards and
11 grants to state agencies in accordance with applicable laws
12 and regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
13 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
14 2009.

15 Section 45. The additional sum of \$500,000, or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
17 Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
18 Information Authority for Violence Against Women awards and
19 grants to state agencies in accordance with applicable laws
20 and regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
21 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
22 2009.

1 Section 50. The additional sum of \$15,000,000, or so
 2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 3 Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 4 Information Authority for Byrne/JAG awards and grants to
 5 state agencies in accordance with applicable laws and
 6 regulations for the State portion of federal funds made
 7 available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
 8 2009.

9 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 10 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
 11 Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities
 12 undertaken in support of federal assistance programs
 13 administered by units of state and local government and non-
 14 profit organizations:

3 Section 60. The following named amounts, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
5 Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants
6 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other
7 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit
8 organizations for activities undertaken in support of
9 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking
10 other criminal justice information projects:

16 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects

19 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards,
20 grants and operational support to implement the Motor Vehicle
21 Theft Prevention Act:

13 Section 70. The sum of \$4,500,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Juvenile
15 Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the
16 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards
17 and grants to state agencies and units of local government,
18 including operational expenses of the Authority in support of
19 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
21 2010.
