11 WHEREAS, He has a Bachelor of Arts degree from St. Louis 12 University and a Master of Arts in Urban Planning from Loyola 13 University of Chicago; he is married to Robin, and they have 14 two children, Michelle and Scott; he is an Adjunct Professor at 15 Harper College in Palatine; and he is an avid reader and 16 runner, a poor golfer, and a political junkie; therefore, be it
