## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/Art. 48 heading new

720 ILCS 5/48-1 new

720 ILCS 5/48-5 new

720 ILCS 5/48-10 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the Gang-related Crimes Law. Creates the offense of active participation in a criminal street gang. Provides that a person commits the offense who actively participates in any criminal street gang with knowledge that its members engage in or have engaged in a course or pattern of criminal gang activity, and who willfully promotes, furthers, assists, or benefits from any felonious criminal conduct by members of that criminal street gang. Provides that a person who commits active participation in a criminal street gang is guilty of conspiracy to commit the felonious conduct of the criminal street gang. Creates the offense of disorderly promotion of a criminal street gang. Provides that a person commits the offense when he or she knowingly speaks a gang-related name or flashes a gang-related sign or symbol in such an unreasonable manner so as to alarm or disturb another and to provoke a breach of the peace. Provides that a violation is a Class C misdemeanor.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding

- 7 <u>ARTICLE 48. GANG-RELATED CRIMES</u>

- 9 <u>Sec. 48-1. Short title. This Article may be cited as the</u>
- 10 Gang-related Crimes Law.
- 11 (720 ILCS 5/48-5 new)
- 12 Sec. 48-5. Active participation in a criminal street gang.
- 13 (a) A person commits active participation in a criminal
- 14 street gang who actively participates in any criminal street
- gang with knowledge that its members engage in or have engaged
- in a course or pattern of criminal gang activity, and who
- 17 willfully promotes, furthers, assists, or benefits from any
- 18 felonious criminal conduct by members of that criminal street
- 19 gang. A person who commits active participation in a criminal
- 20 street gang is quilty of conspiracy to commit the felonious
- 21 conduct of the criminal street gang.

- 1 (b) Sentence. A person convicted of active participation in
- 2 <u>a criminal street gang may be sentenced in accordance with</u>
- 3 <u>Section 8-2 of this Code.</u>

- 6 them in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus

- 9 Sec. 48-10. Disorderly promotion of a criminal street gang.
- 10 (a) A person commits disorderly promotion of a criminal
- 11 street gang when he or she knowingly speaks a gang-related name
- 12 or flashes a gang-related sign or symbol in such an
- 13 unreasonable manner so as to alarm or disturb another and to
- provoke a breach of the peace.
- 15 (b) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class C
- 16 misdemeanor.
- 17 (c) In this Section, "criminal street gang" has the meaning
- 18 ascribed to it in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang
- 19 Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act; and "gang-related name" and
- 20 <u>"gang-related sign or symbol" mean any name, sign or other</u>
- 21 symbol intended to identify a criminal street gang.
