Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 12 (625 ILCS 5/1-140.15 new)
- Sec. 1-140.15. Low-speed gas bicycle. A 2 or 3-wheeled
- 14 <u>device with fully operable pedals and a gasoline motor of less</u>
- than one horsepower, whose maximum speed on a paved level
- surface, when powered solely by such a motor while ridden by an
- operator who weighs 170 pounds, is less than 20 miles per hour.
- 18 (625 ILCS 5/1-146) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-146)
- 19 Sec. 1-146. Motor vehicle. Every vehicle which is
- 20 self-propelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric
- 21 power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated

- upon rails, except for vehicles moved solely by human power, 1
- 2 and motorized wheelchairs, low-speed electric bicycles, and
- 3 low-speed gas bicycles. For this Act, motor vehicles are
- divided into two divisions: 4
- 5 First Division: Those motor vehicles which are designed for
- the carrying of not more than 10 persons. 6
- 7 Second Division: Those motor vehicles which are designed
- 8 for carrying more than 10 persons, those motor vehicles
- 9 designed or used for living quarters, those motor vehicles
- 10 which are designed for pulling or carrying freight, cargo or
- 11 implements of husbandry, and those motor vehicles of the First
- 12 Division remodelled for use and used as motor vehicles of the
- 13 Second Division.

- 16 Sec. 11-1516. Low-speed bicycles.
- (a) A person may operate a low-speed electric bicycle or 17
- low-speed gas bicycle only if the person is at least 16 years 18
- 19 of age.
- 20 (b) A person may not operate a low-speed electric bicycle
- 21 or low-speed gas bicycle at a speed greater than 20 miles per
- 22 hour upon any highway, street, or roadway.
- 23 (c) A person may not operate a low-speed electric bicycle
- 24 or low-speed gas bicycle on a sidewalk.
- (d) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, the 25

- provisions of this Article XV that apply to bicycles also apply 1
- 2 to low-speed electric bicycles and low-speed gas bicycles.
