1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 642 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 642 as follows: in Section 5, Sec. 7, subsec. (c), the paragraph beginning "The 3 obligation", the sentence beginning "The resolution may also 4 authorize", by replacing "Board." with the following: 5 6 "Board. 7 If the Board of Trustees elects to exercise the power to borrow money as provided in this subsection (c), the question 8 of whether each trustee shall be retained in office for the 9 remainder of his or her term must be submitted to the electors 10 11 at the next general election. Sixty days before that election, the Governor and the Secretary of State shall certify to the 12 State Board of Elections the name of each trustee that will be 13 14 or is reasonably expected to be serving on the board on and after the date of the general election. The question shall be 15
