1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended by changing Section 6 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 60/6) (from Ch. 111, par. 4400-6)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on December 31, 2010)
- Sec. 6. It is declared to be <u>the</u> the public policy of this State, pursuant to paragraphs (h) and (i) of Section 6 of
- 10 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, that any
- 11 power or function set forth in this Act to be exercised by the
- 12 State is an exclusive State power or function. Such power or
- function shall not be exercised concurrently, either directly
- or indirectly, by any unit of local government, including home
- rule units, except as otherwise provided in this Act.
